<p>Guided Reading</p>	<p>All children take part in daily guided reading lessons that focus on promoting pupil's phonics knowledge and decoding at word level, reading for enjoyment, developing reading stamina, and exploring texts to improve comprehension skills. Children are engaged in reading a variety of carefully selected books within a group setting.
