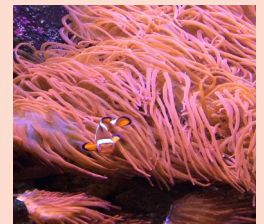




## Year 4 Blue Planet Aquarium
